## **APPLICATION PROCESS FOR STUDENT PARKING PERMITS**

Parking passes are distributed to students beginning at noon on Thursday, August 15, 2024.

To receive a pass, students must complete the application and pay in full, either by coming to the office from 10am to 3pm, Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, with the completed application and payment, or mailing in the application with a check. Only one parking pass per family / household, please.

For 2024-25, a Heritage parking pass for the full year costs **\$225.00**.

The few remaining spaces are available at a discount, with a cost of \$200 beginning October 1, and an additional \$25 decrease effective the first of each subsequent month (\$175 on November 1, \$150 on December 1, etc.)

Acceptable forms of payment are:

Apply by mail: Send completed application with a check and a clearly printed email address on line 3, to: Heritage UU Church 2710 Newtown Rd. Cincinnati, OH 45244

Passes are assigned to complete applications with payment as they come into the office. Pick up your pass beginning at noon on Thursday, August 15, or avoid the line by coming later that day (up to 3:30 pm), or during the office hours listed below for delivering and picking up applications.

**Apply in person:** Come to Heritage UU Church at 2710 Newtown Rd., Cincinnati 45244 with a completed application and payment in full (check or cash, exact change please). You will receive the pass at that time.

## PARKING REGULATIONS

- 10. I understand my parking permit may be revoked without refund and my car may be towed if these regulations are violated or if I am found to be in violation of the Turpin Student Code of Conduct.
