

APPLICATION PROCESS FOR STUDENT 2026-27 PARKING PERMITS

Parking passes are distributed to students beginning at noon on Wednesday, August 12, 2026.

To receive a pass, students must complete the application and pay in full, either by coming to the office in person once distribution begins (noon, Wednesday, August 12) or by mailing the current application form with a check payable to HUUC ("parking" in memo). Spaces are assigned after a completed application form and full payment are received by mail or in person. DO NOT deliver applications prior to August 12. Only one parking pass per family / household, please.

For 2026-27, a Heritage parking pass costs **\$225.00**. The rate is reduced by \$25 per month beginning Oct. 1 until all available spaces are assigned. The schedule is on the website.

Acceptable forms of payment are:

Cash (exact change only, please)

Check made payable to HUUC (please write "parking" in the memo line).

Do not hand deliver the application prior to noon on Wednesday, August 12. Do not mail cash.

Parking spaces are assigned to complete applications with payment as they arrive in the mail.

Pick up your pass between noon and 3:00pm on Wednesday, August 12. Avoid the line by arriving at 12:15pm. On Thursday, August 13, and on Wednesday, August 19 passes may be picked up during the hours listed below.

You will receive notice that the application has been received ONLY if the information is incomplete. You may call (513-231-8634) or email (HUUCoffice@yahoo.com) to confirm a pass has been assigned. If the pass is not picked up by Thursday, August 13, you will receive an email listing your assigned space where you may park starting August 19. Note, no applications will be processed from August 14 to August 24.

Apply in person: Come to Heritage UU Church at 2710 Newtown Rd., Cincinnati 45244 with a completed application and payment in full (check or cash, exact change please). You will receive the pass at that time.

Office hours to deliver application and/or pick up pass:

Wednesday, August 12: noon to 3:00 pm

Thursday, August 13: 10:30 am to 3:30 pm.

Wednesday, August 19: 1:30 to 3:30 pm.

After and including Monday, August 24:

The church office is open M, W, Th, and F 10:30 am - 3:30 pm.

The church office is closed on Tuesdays.

PARKING REGULATIONS

Because parking on church property is a privilege, I agree to abide by the following regulations. I understand that violation of these rules and regulations may result in the loss of my parking pass.

1. I will drive in a courteous, safe manner at all times and observe a **speed limit of 10 mph** while on church property.
2. I will respect church property and neighboring right of way; I will not litter; I will carry out my own trash.
3. I understand Heritage Church is a Non-Smoking facility, both indoors and outdoors.
4. I will park only in my assigned space; I will not park in reserved parking spaces.
5. I will not park in front of the recycling or garbage bins.
6. I have purchased the permit for use by myself only (or a household member also named on the application) for use for curricular and extracurricular Turpin activities only. (Permits not valid for football games).
7. I will be responsible for any violations that may occur with my parking permit number.
8. I understand my vehicle may be searched by an administrator of Turpin High School if there is a reason to believe that items in my car may be in violation of the Student Code of Conduct.
9. I understand my parking permit may be revoked without refund and my car may be towed if these regulations are violated or if I am found to be in violation of the Turpin Student Code of Conduct.
